

RECRUITMENT RULES

PRINCIPAL

Essential :

(01) Having B.Y.N.S./B.A.M.S. degree and P.G. Degree or Diploma in Yoga and Naturopathy of minimum 2 year's duration from a recognized university.

OR

M.D.(Ayurved) in Swasthavritta/Kayachikitsa/Basic Principles from a recognized university

OR

A Yoga expert with Ph.D./M.Phil.in Yoga/Yoga and Naturopathy from a recognized University.

(02) 10 years experience of teaching/research in Swasthavritta/Yoga/Yoga and Naturopathy with minimum 05 year's administrative experience.

(03) Age not more than 65 years.

(04) Computer knowledge as per the Government Rules.

Desirable:

(01) Having Ph.D.in the concerned subject as mentioned above.

(02) Published original papers, books, monographs etc. on the concerned subjects.

(03) Having done Diploma/Certificate Course/Training Course in Yoga/Yoga & Naturopathy from recognized University/Government institution.

(04) Good command over Sanskrit, Hindi and English Languages, knowledge of Gujarati Language.

Essential M.D.(Ayu) in Swasthavritta/ Basic Principles / Kayachikitsa from Recognised University

OR

B.N.Y.S./ B.Y.N.S. / B.S.A.M./ B.A.M.S./ M.B.B.S./B.H.M.S. or its equivalent from Recognised University, along with P.G. D.Y.N. from any Recognised University/Institute.

- Age limit for the post of lecturers will be maximum 40 Years

LECTURER IN AYUROPATHY:

Essential M.D.(Ayu) in Swasthavritta/ Basic Principles / Kayachikitsa from Recognised University

OR

B.N.Y.S./ B.Y.N.S. / B.S.A.M./ B.A.M.S./ M.B.B.S./B.H.M.S. or its equivalent from Recognised University, with P.G. D.Y.N.

- Age limit for the post of lecturers will be maximum 40 Years
- Computer Knowledge as per Govt. rule

02. Professor in Yogic sciences: Pay scale- Rs. 12000-420-18300

Essential:

- (a) A degree in Ayurved/Yoga or Yoga and Nisargopachara from a university established by law or a Statutory Board / Faculty / Examining Body of Indian Medicine or its equivalent as recognized by the Council for Nisargopachara and Yoga.
- (b) A Post Graduate degree in Yoga and Nisargopachara (Equivalent to M. D.) from a university established by law or a Statutory Board / Faculty / Examining Body of Indian Medicine or its equivalent as recognized by the Council for Nisargopachara and Yoga.

OR

M. D. (Ayu.) in Swasthavrutta

OR

M. D. (Ayu.) or M. S. (Ayu.) in any speciality along with P. G. Diploma in Yoga and Naturopathy.

- (c) Teaching experience of 10 years as a full time teacher of which at least five years teaching experience in the specialized subjects as Reader.

OR

B.N.Y.S./ B.Y.N.S. / B.S.A.M./ B.A.M.S./ M.B.B.S./ B.H.M.S. or its equivalent from Recognised University, with P.G. D.Y.N. with minimum teaching experience of 13 Yrs. out of which minimum 05 Yrs. as a Reader in the specialized subject.

Desirable

- (a) Ph. D. in Yoga and Nisargopachara from a university established by law or a Statutory Board / Faculty / Examining Body of Indian Medicine or its equivalent as recognized by the Council for Nisargopachara and Yoga.

OR

Ph. D. in the subject of Ayurved from any recognized Institution / University established by law.

- (b) Original published papers / books on the subject.

- (c) Good knowledge of Sanskrit, Hindi, English and Gujarati.

Readers

01. Reader in Nisargopachara: Pay scale- Rs. 10000-325-15200

Essential :

- (a) A degree in Nisargopachara or Yoga and Nisargopachara from a university established by law or a Statutory Board / Faculty / Examining Body of Indian Medicine or its equivalent as recognized by the Council for Nisargopachara and Yoga.

OR

A degree in Ayurved from a University established by law or a Statutory Board/Faculty / Examining Body of Indian Medicine or its equivalent as recognized under Indian Medicine Central Council Act-1970.

- (b) A Post Graduate degree in Yoga and Nisargopachara (Equivalent to M. D.) from a university established by law or a Statutory Board / Faculty / Examining Body of Indian Medicine or its equivalent as recognized by the Council for Nisargopachara and Yoga.

OR

M. D. (Ayu.) in Swasthavrutta / M. D. (Ayu.) or M. S. (Ayu.) in any speciality along with P. G. diploma in Yoga and Naturopathy.

- (c) Teaching experience of 5 years as a full time teacher in the specialized subject of which 3 years teaching experience as Lecturer.

OR

B.N.Y.S./ B.Y.N.S. / B.S.A.M./ B.A.M.S./ M.B.B.S./ B.H.M.S. or its equivalent from Recognised University, with P.G.D.Y.N. with minimum teaching experience of 08 Yrs. as a Lecturer in the specialized subject.

Desirable:

- (a) Ph. D. in Yoga and Nisargopachara from a university established by law or a Statutory Board / Faculty / Examining Body of Indian Medicine or its equivalent as recognized by the Council for Nisargopachara and Yoga.

OR

Ph. D. in the subject of Ayurved from any recognized Institution / University established by law.

- (b) Original published papers / books on the subject.
(c) Good knowledge of Sanskrit, Hindi, English and Gujarati.

13. Qualifications and Experience for teaching staff.- The qualifications and experience for teaching staff shall be as follows:-

(a) Essential qualification-

- (i) A Bachelor degree in Ayurveda from a University or its equivalent as recognised under the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970; and
- (ii) A Post-graduate qualification in the subject or speciality concerned included in the Schedule to the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970.

(b) Experience-

- (i) For the post of Professor: Ten years teaching experience in concerned subject or five years teaching experience as Associate Professor (Reader) in concerned subject or ten years research experience in regular service in Research Councils of Central Government or State Government or Union territory or University or National Institutions with minimum five papers published in a recognised journal.
- (ii) For the post of Reader or Associate Professor: Five years teaching experience in concerned subject or five years research experience in regular service in Research Councils of Central Government or State Government or Union territory or University or National Institutions with minimum three papers published in a recognised journal.
- (iii) For the post of Assistant Professor or Lecturer: The age shall not exceed forty-five years at the time of first appointment and it may be relaxed for in-service candidates as per the existing rules.

Note: Priority shall be given to the candidates having Doctoral in Ayurveda.

(c) Qualification and experience for the post of Head of the Institution -The qualification and experience for the post of Head of the Institution (Principal or Dean or Director) shall be the same qualification and experience prescribed for the post of Professor.

(d) Provision of allied subject- In absence of the candidate of post-graduate qualification in the subject concerned as mentioned in column (2) of the table, the candidate of post-graduate qualification in the allied subjects as mentioned in column (3) of the table, shall be considered eligible for the post of Lecturer or Assistant Professor, Reader or Associate Professor and Professor:-

Note 3: The research experience of regular Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) holder may be considered equivalent to one year teaching experience.
