Host institution: Institute for Post Graduate Teaching and Research in Ayurveda, Gujarat Ayurved University, is a best academic place for learning and research in Ayurveda. Govt. of India started a Central Institute for Research in Indigenous Medicine (CIRISM) in 1952 and looking into the needs of the time, a post graduate teaching and research institute was established on 20th July 1956 by Govt. of India for revival of Ayurveda in its authentic form. It was later renamed as 'Institute for Post Graduate Teaching and Research in Ayurveda' in 1965 after merger of CIRISM and establishment of Gujarat Ayurved University. Now this Institute is governed by 'Board of PG Teaching & Research' as per amended GAU Act of 2003. This premier PG Institute is completing its 59 years, and 60th foundation day is being celebrated on 20th July 2015. Total 59 batches have been admitted to this premier institute of Ayurveda education and research. Nearly 237 Ph.D. degrees, 1597 HPA / MSAM / M.D. (Ay) degrees, 77 M.Sc. (Medicinal Plants) and 103 M. Pharma (Ayu.) degrees were awarded by Gujarat Ayurved University. It is the only collaborative centre in Traditional Medicine (Ayurveda) for WHO throughout the World. The institute has been designated as National Pharmacovigilance Resource Centre (NPRC) for ASU Drugs.

About the National Workshop:

Since the day of inception this institute is globally recognized for its Ayurvedic approach in teaching, research and service delivery to the ailing humanity. Two days National Workshop on **"PANCHAKARMA-A CONTEMPORARY APPROACH"** is being organized by the

institute on the occasion of 60th foundation day celebrations of IPGT & RA.

Background

Panchakarma therapy of Ayurveda has been receiving special attention in the recent days world around. This therapy has faced the transition in the history and has diversity of different therapeutic modules in different corners of the nation. Ayurveda physicians from the different part of the country are practicing Panchakarma in their clinical specialty areas. Many conferences and seminars are also conducted in different institutes sharing possibilities for research and standardization in the field of Panchakarma. It was considered wise on such occasion to invite few luminaries to share their knowledge and experience in front of the teachers and students.

Considering this, it is planned to organize a two days National Workshop on Panchakarma by IPGT & RA, Gujarat Ayurved University, Jamnagar during 20-21 July 2015.

Theme of the workshop

The below areas will be focused during the technical sessions

1. Researches and innovations in Panchakarma
2. Panchakarma instrumentation
3. Clinical practices of Panchakarma

PM Mehta Memorial Oration: In fond memory of Late Dr. PM Mehta, who was instrumental in establishment of Ayurveda education centre in Jamnagar; a memorial oration in his name was started in 1988. On this occasion; 27th Dr. P. M. Mehta Memorial Oration will be delivered by Dr. Madhavankutti Warriar

Guest speakers and topics:

During the scientific sessions, learned speakers from the subject of Panchakarma from different parts of the country will deliver lectures on the themes specified.

Call for Papers:

During the seminar, there will be paper presentation (Oral/Poster) sessions. Original research papers from scientists and scholars are invited for presentation during the seminar. Only 10 papers will be selected for oral presentation (time for presentation max. 8 min). Other selected 20 papers will be consider for poster presentation.

Format for paper submission:

Abstract & Full Papers - Abstract in MS word, times new roman font, 12 size, 1.5 line space, not exceeding 200 words in A4 paper.

Last date for submission of Abstract: 05th July, 2015

Last date for submission of full paper: 10th July, 2015

The properly filled up registration form should reach the organizing secretary on or before 10th July 2015. No spot registration will be allowed.
